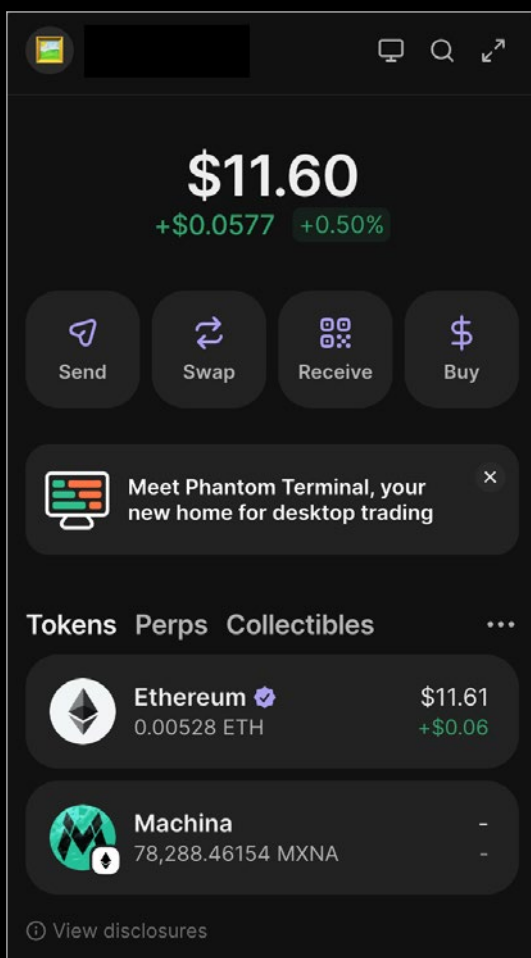


How to Bridge MXNA (ETH → SOL)

Prerequisites

- A “source wallet” holding **MXNA on Ethereum (ERC-20)**
- Sufficient **ETH for gas fees**
- A “destination wallet” / **Solana wallet** (e.g. Phantom) to receive MXNA on Solana

Example source wallet:

Has MXNA on ETH

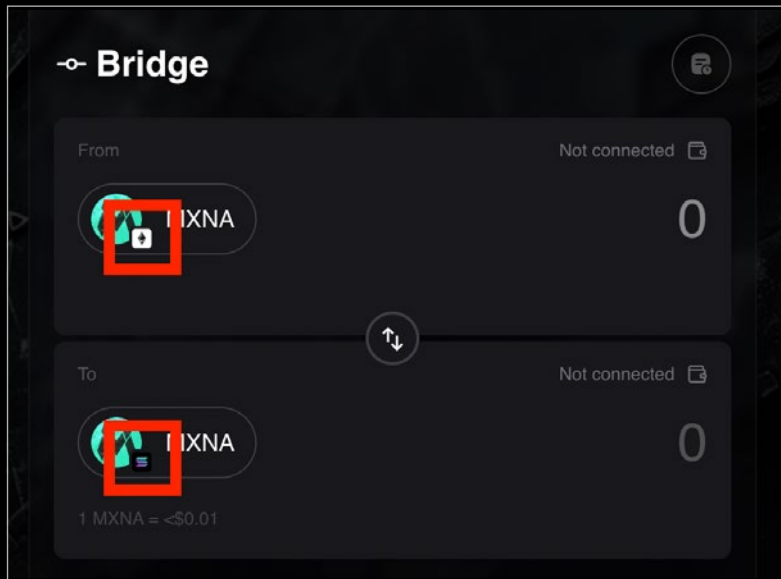
Step 1 - Select Bridge Direction


Confirm:

From: MXNA (Ethereum)

To: MXNA (Solana)

The chain can be determined by looking here (see below)

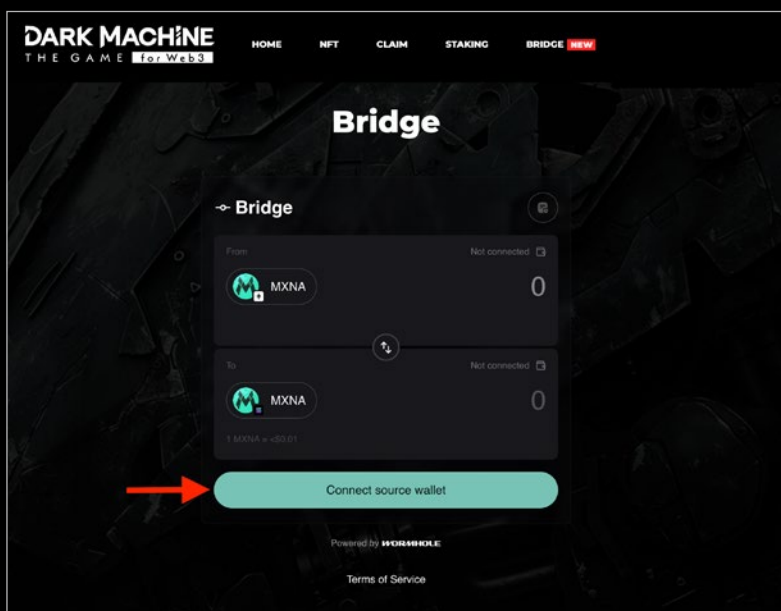


*Click the  icon to swap direction.

Step 2 - Connect Your Wallet (Ethereum)

Click **“Connect source wallet”** (bottom)

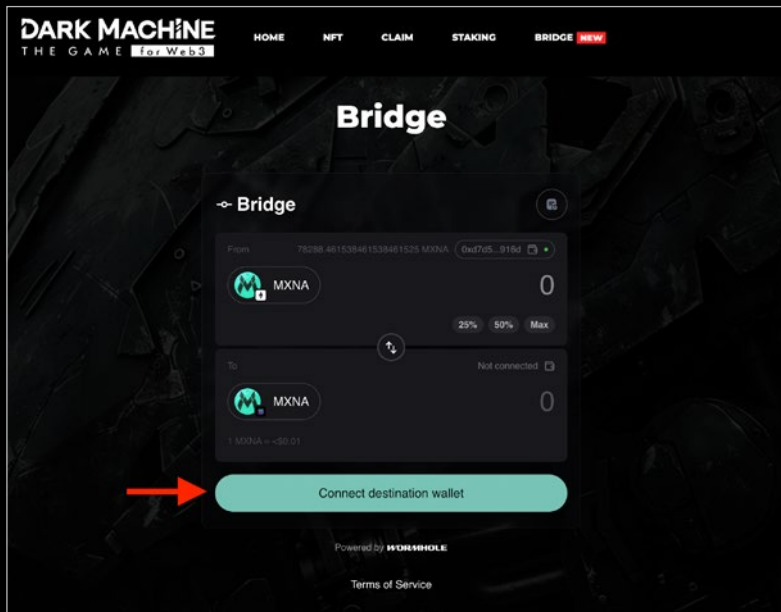
Connect your **Ethereum wallet** (e.g. Phantom, MetaMask)



Step 3 - Connect Your Wallet (Solana)

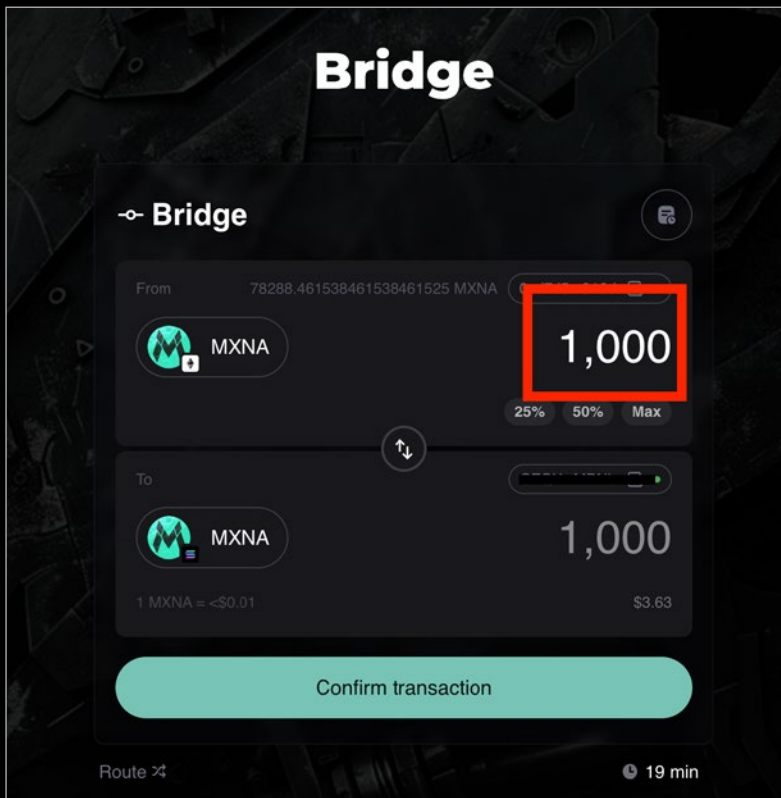
Click **“Connect destination wallet”** (bottom)

Connect your **Solana wallet** (e.g. Phantom)



Step 4 - Enter Amount

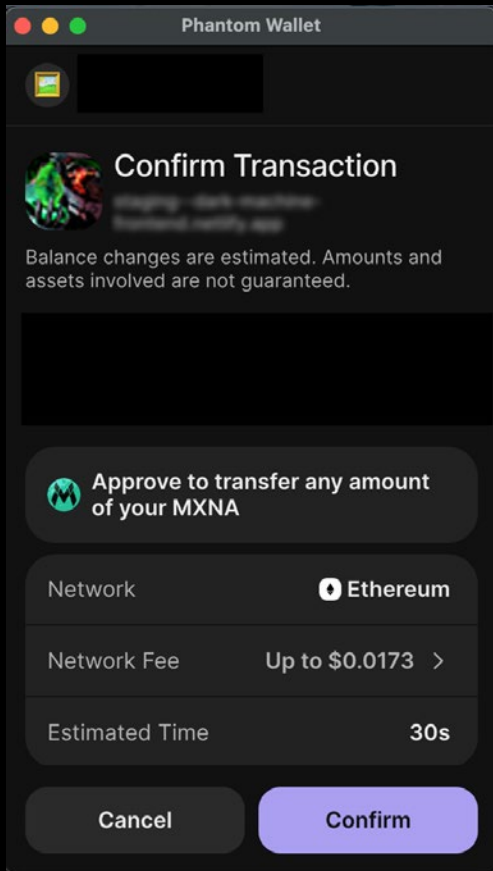
Input the amount of **MXNA (ETH)** you want to bridge.



Step 5 - Approve Transaction

Click **“Confirm Transaction”**.

Then, Confirm the approval in your wallet source wallet.



Step 6 - Wait for Completion

Bridging may take a few minutes.
